



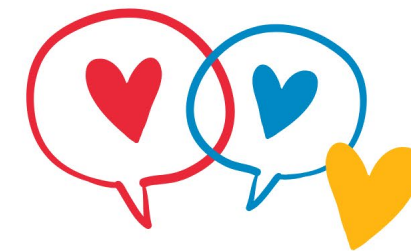

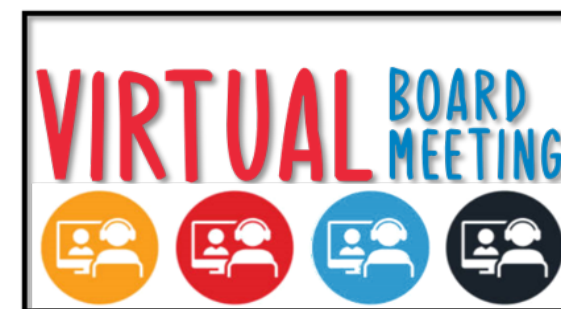
There will not be a Board of Directors meeting in June.

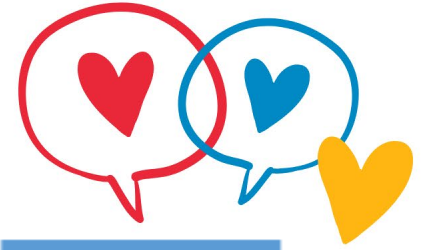

Emergent Literacy Training Requirements

The **deadline of July 1, 2022**, is fast approaching and all VPK instructors must have completed all three components of the emergent literacy trainings . This is your last chance for completing component 3 the virtual reflection sessions requirement.

To register for the reflective session, you will need to go to the [DCF training website](#) and enter one of the course numbers listed below. The reflective sessions are scheduled from 6-7 pm each night. As a reminder, all of the training listed on the DCF training website are listed in eastern time.



Emergent Literacy Training Requirements



Florida law now requires every prekindergarten classroom to have at least one prekindergarten instructor who has completed three five-hour emergent literacy training courses. Prior to the passage of House Bill (HB) 419 and HB 7011 in 2021, only one emergent literacy training course was required. Thus, continuing prekindergarten instructors, who have already completed one five-hour emergent literacy training course, must complete two additional courses. Any new prekindergarten instructors must take all three classes.

This legislative change became effective on July 1, 2021. The Department of Education, Division of Early Learning (DEL), gave notice of this new requirement and identified ten emergent literacy training courses that meet this requirement. Given the importance of this training, DEL set a **deadline of July 1, 2022**, for all prekindergarten providers to meet this requirement. After completing the first three emergent literacy courses, Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) instructors must complete one emergent literacy course every five years.

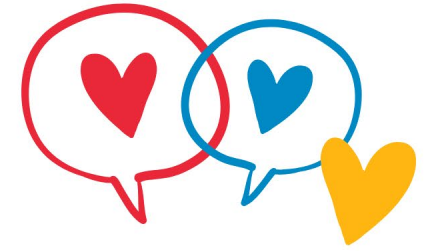

ASQ System Changes to be Implemented



Thank you to all the School Readiness Providers that attended the virtual 30-min ASQ Provider Training in May.

Things to Remember:

- We will no longer be using the Family Access Link to share with the Parent to complete their child's ASQ.
- Screenings are to be completed in the Developmental Screening Queue of the Provider Portal.
- Parent's will need to complete their child's ASQs from the Family Portal upon completing new enrollment or redetermination paperwork.
- REMIND the parent that they have 5 days to complete the screening in their Family Portal. If the Screening is not completed in 5 days, the Provider is required to complete the screening and will populate in you Developmental Screening Queue.
- ASQ3 and ASQ:SE are required to be completed if the parent has not opted out of the screenings.
