THE INTENTIONAL TEACHER

Before we plan, manage, or teach — we believe. This immersive session invites teachers to examine their personal teaching philosophies and connect them to daily classroom decisions. Through facilitated dialogue, reflective journaling, and collaborative scenarios, participants unpack what it truly means to teach young children — and why the process always matters more than the product.

PLANNING WITH PURPOSE

Standards don't have to feel like a checklist — they can be a launchpad. In this hands-on session, teachers work through a planning cycle that connects early learning standards to meaningful curriculum experiences. Participants leave with a draft lesson plan they actually want to teach, built around the children in their room. Participants must complete Room Arrangement training as a prerequisite.

HANDS-ON, SCREENS OFF

Young children learn by doing — and this session proves it. Teachers rotate through hands-on learning stations featuring music and movement integration, open-ended STEAM challenges, and creative provocations using everyday, low-tech materials. The result: a toolkit of ready-to-use activities that spark curiosity without requiring a screen.

FROM CHAOS TO CALM

The moments between activities are where the day is won or lost. This action-packed session tackles the three most common classroom pressure points — transitions, challenging behavior, and supporting children at different developmental levels — with practical, research-informed strategies. Participants practice real scenarios and build a personalized classroom management plan.

BRIDGES TO LEARNING

Literacy begins long before kindergarten — and it thrives when families are part of the journey. This session blends early literacy best practices with practical family engagement strategies. Teachers explore how to create rich language environments in the classroom and build authentic, two-way relationships with the families they serve.
